6. INFORMING PROTESTEE (How did you inform the protestee of your intention to protest?)

7. DESCRIPTION OF INCIDENT:

Both vessels are alleged to have entered the designated shipping lanes at night and did not respond to repeated hails on VHF from Seattle VTS. Vessels did not respond to Satphone calls from Race Committee. Vessels may have responded (after delay) to Email Request from Race Committee.

Seattle VTS incident report indicates that they advised commercial traffic following the Traffic Separation Scheme to alter course to avoid both vessels.

FOR USE BY PROTEST COMMITTEE:

Upon agreement with both boats on facts found and penalty, Race Committee has withdrawn the protest. This decision upheld by Protest Committee

FACTS FOUND

Serenite - As Agreed by Victor Mushkatin, Skipper

As supported by the Incident Report provided by USCG Seattle Traffic Services, Serenite did not adhere to provisions related to IRPCAS 10 j and caused commercial traffic in the appropriate shipping lane to alter course. Further, Serenite did not maintain appropriate communication watch in failing to respond to VHF hail by Seattle VTS or satphone call from Race Committee.

Serenite is penalized 24 hours for causing commercial traffic to alter course Serenite is penalized a further 4 hours for failure to maintain adequate communication watch.

Both penalties will be added to Serenite's elapsed time.

Gemini's Dream

Gemini's Dream retired from the race and returned to home port. No further time penalties are assessed

Both Boats

Both boats are required to send a letter to USCG Seattle Vessel Traffic Services outlining their understanding of the importance of adhering to proper procedures when travelling within Traffic Separation Schemes.
